In other versions of this talk, D'Souza covers different aspects of his book. Here are some important highlights!

Key point: Three of Hitler's most central principles and homicidal ideas actually came from the LEFT & the Democratic party.

1 – The Nazis got their eugenics methods that resulted in the euthanasia of large numbers of people in lethal chambers from American eugenicists of the Progressive movement. (as discussed in this video).

2 - The Nazis copied the methods by which the southern Democrats had created their racist slave culture. In crafting the Nuremberg Laws that denied Jews citizenship, the Nazis had to determine what constituted a "Jew." With help from a Nazi who had studied in Arkansas, they analyzed the way in which American Democrats had determined what constituted a "black person." The Nazis felt that the Democrats' criteria were way too harsh! In analyzing America's race laws and applying them to the Jews, the most radical of the Nazis found the American Democrats to be too extreme!

3 - The Nazis copied the Democrat's process of Indians conquest and relocation in how they handled the Jews. Germany had a colonization problem. They wanted to colonize like other European countries, but there was nowhere left to colonize. Hitler read about the American Indians and realized he could colonize the very same way right in Europe. In America, President Jackson had thrown Indians off their land and displaced them, and if they remained, they were enslaved. The Nazis did the same to the Jews.

Note: FDR was a big fan of Mussolini! He dispatched members of his Brain Trust to study Mussolini's Italian model and bring it to the US! He had a vision for a planned economy in the United States and worked to implement it through the New Deal.

- Roosevelt himself called Mussolini "admirable" and professed that he was "deeply impressed by what he has accomplished." The admiration was mutual. In a laudatory review of Roosevelt's 1933 book *Looking Forward*, Mussolini wrote, "Reminiscent of Fascism is the principle that the state no longer leaves the economy to its own devices.... Without question, the mood accompanying this sea change resembles that of Fascism." The chief Nazi newspaper, *Volkischer Beobachter*, repeatedly praised "Roosevelt's adoption of National Socialist strains of thought in his economic and social policies" and "the development toward an authoritarian state" based on the "demand that collective good be put before individual self-interest."
